But on my phone, it keeps showing me the error message "File name contains invalid characters". I tried the "Filter" in the "Overwrite Files". The filter was only in "All Files (*.*)", not in "Images". I also tried the "Upload File" settings. Then, I tried to upload the zip folder, which is inside the folder, and use "File name contains invalid characters". And the upload was successful. Why it shows the error on my phone? A: I had to use "File name contains invalid characters" and "Restore to folder" in the "Overwrite Files" options. That solved the problem. Q: How to transfer a file (in Linux) via socket from localhost to the remote machine? I want to send a file from the localhost to the remote machine by socket.
